Come to school dressed in warm pyjamas and slippers.

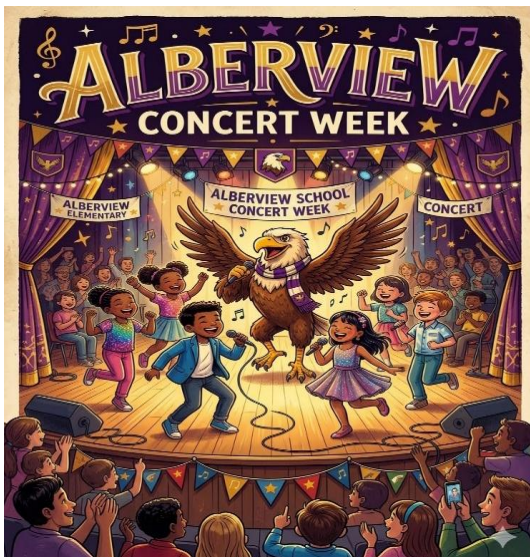

13. SCHOOL FEES

Alberview Primary School is a fee-paying school, and school fees must be paid regularly. Parents who are unable to settle the full annual amount in advance may make monthly payments from January to December 2026.

Consistent monthly payments help prevent accounts from falling into arrears and reduce the need for reminders or further collection procedures. School fees are essential to sustaining the quality of education, facilities and services provided by the school.

Parents are informed of the following year's school fees in November, following the Annual General Meeting. The fees are communicated again in the end-of-year circular accompanying final reports and at the beginning of the new school year. Unless the annual amount is paid in full at the start of the year, fees must be paid monthly. Parents are encouraged to set up a monthly debit order to ensure payments are made consistently and on time.

Regular reminders will be sent to parents whose accounts are in arrears. During September or October, a Section 41 notice will be issued where accounts remain outstanding. This notice does not mean that the account has already been handed over for collection. It serves as formal notification that the outstanding balance should be settled before the end of the academic year to avoid further collection procedures. Parents who require clarification are requested to contact the school office in writing.

When making a payment, please use the correct **BENEFICIARY REFERENCE**, namely the account number reflected on the right-hand side of your school fee statement. This reference was also included in the acceptance email sent when your child was admitted to the school.

14. PE, SCHOOL AND FRIDAY UNIFORM
