Dear Parents/Guardians

Please take note of the following important dates and information.

1. REPORT CARDS

Report cards will be handed out on Thursday 25 June 2026 in the school hall between 18:00 – 19:00 ONLY. Parents will sign on a class list so the school has evidence that reports were collected and that parents are aware of their child's results.

This is only for collection. No parent meetings will take place. If you would like to see the teacher, please set up a meeting to discuss results, concerns etc.

Parents/Guardians who did not collect reports on Thursday, will be asked to come and collect after the holiday by making an appointment to see the class teacher.

No report will be sent home with a learner on the Friday when school closes. The front office will also not hand out any learner reports before or after the set date and time.

2. LEARNER RESULTS

Learners who did not meet the passing requirements for Term 1 and Term 2 are in danger to repeat the current grade. It is very important that parents support at home by doing daily reading. Most learners struggle, because they don't read with comprehension/understanding. Reading must be a non-negotiable in every home.

3. SCHOOL CLOSURE

School closes on Friday 26 June 2026 at 10:00 and will reopen on 21 July 2026.

4. PUBLIC HOLIDAYS

Monday 15 June is a school holiday. Tuesday 16 June is Youth Day. Learners return to school on Wednesday 17 June 2026.

5. LUNCH AND COMMUNICATION

Parents may not ask teachers to buy lunch for their children. If lunch is forgotten, they may drop it off at the office or arrange payment plans with Mr. Britz. This is happening too often and does not form part of a teacher's job description.

WhatsApp is for general information from the teachers or the school to the parents. Private messages will only be responded to, when teachers are not teaching. Email should be the first line of communication.

6. THE TRAVELLING BOOKSHOP IS COMING TO SCHOOL.

We are excited to host the Travelling Bookshop soon. We encourage all families to support this wonderful initiative.

Learners are welcome to buy as many new books as they wish during the day. Parents are also warmly invited to browse and shop in the hall after school.

7. LATE ARRIVALS

Many learners arrive late to school some even after register period. **We do not want to create a culture of late coming.**

Take note of the following: Learners who arrive late, will receive demerits after every 3rd time they are late. Eventually this will lead to break detention. This means parents and transport drivers need to step up and ensure learners are at school on time.

If you do not want your child to accumulate demerits and eventually have a break detention, ensure you drop them off before 07:30. Being on time is a life skill that all learners must learn from a young age.

8. ROAD RULES

So many parents and transport drivers act extremely rudely and disrespectful towards the staff and security while they are on duty to ensure the safety of your children. Some parents and transport providers stop wherever they like. When they are asked to move their car, they become dismissive and aggressive towards staff or simply ignore the staff.

Learners also think they can speak to adults in the same manner because of the example that is shown by the adults in their lives. Following road rules is not an Alberview rule but a national rule.

9. PHASING OUT OF GRADE R UNIFORM

Grade R learners are allowed to wear the current Grade R uniform in 2026, but from 2027 we will be phasing out the current uniform. Grade R learners may wear the Alberview summer and winter PE uniform throughout the year.

From 2027 all Grade R learners will wear the purple Alberview PE uniform.

10. WAITING AREA

The repair to the collapsing wall has been completed.

The waiting area in Phantom Street will be locked 30 minutes after school has been dismissed. Monday – Thursday it will be locked at 14:30. On Fridays it will be locked at 13:30. Alberview and the security service provider takes no responsibility or liability for any loss or damage to any learner property, any conflicts or accidents when learners wait on the sidewalk to be collected.

11. EVENTS/FUNDRAISERS TERM 2

Please support our events for the Term to help raise funds for our school. We invest back into the infrastructure, equipment and maintenance of the school. Without funds, we are unable to update, replace or maintain the school. **All events and fundraisers are at the discretion of the parent, no fundraiser is compulsory.**
