Dear Parents/Guardians

Please take note of the following important dates and information.

Under the National Road Traffic Regulations, stopping or parking your vehicle on the wrong side of the road against the flow of traffic is an explicit traffic offence.

In both Graham and Edwards Streets, drivers also often make U-Turns in the road which obstructs and delays the movement of traffic. Making a U-Turn is illegal if it obstructs traffic.



Kindly follow and respect the road rules around the school as we are receiving many complaints from residents as well as other parents on how rude and inconsiderate some parents are when dropping off or collecting their child. You may not stop in the middle, switch on your hazard lights and drop off your child. It is not safe. If anything should happen to your

child, the school will not be held responsible due to negligence of the transport service provider or the parent.

12. SCHOOL FEES

Alberview is a fee-paying school. If you are not able to settle the fees up front, you are able to make monthly payments, from January to December 2026 to settle your fees. Please do not skip any months. Rather pay something than nothing. This will prevent unnecessary emails/SMS and ultimately legal action if no payments are received.

Parents are advised in November, after the AGM, what the New Year's school fees will be.

Regular reminders will be sent to parents whose accounts are in arrears. In September/October a Section 41 notice will be issued to parents whose accounts remain in arrears. **This does not mean your account has been handed over.** It is merely a reminder that you still have 3 months in which to settle any fees owing to the school for the academic year before your account will be handed over for collection. Please do not phone the school to fight because you have received one of these letters.

When making payment please ensure the correct **BENEFICIARY REFERENCE** is used namely the account number reflected on the right-hand side of your school fee statement, see below. The reference was also provided on the acceptance email when your child was accepted to the school.

13. PE, SCHOOL AND FRIDAY UNIFORM
